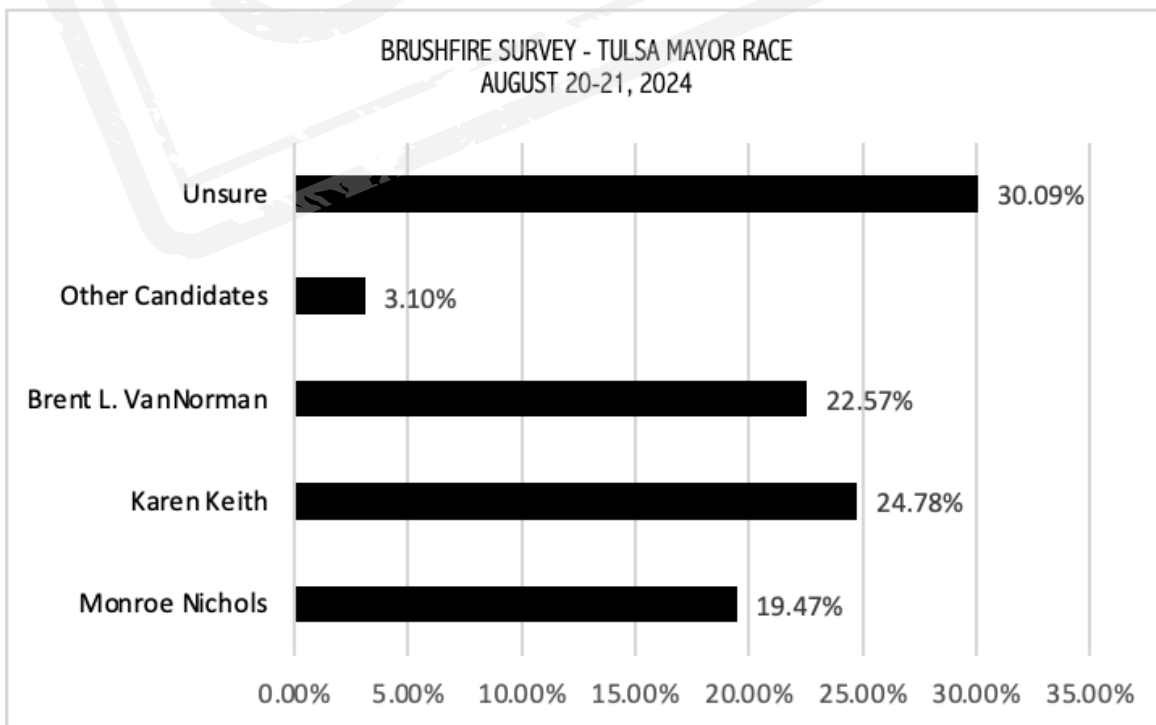
Democrat Karen Keith's Name ID is High, But Republican Businessman Brent VanNorman's Message to Voters is Helping Him Climb, He's Up +4.57 PTS in last 9 days, and Unsures Climb +7

TULSA, OK - Today, a third public opinion poll result has been published for the Tulsa Mayor race. While many voters may be reaching *response fatigue* due to *overpolling* by many political races, including the race for the White House, the results described herein provide a detectable direction: The clear momentum appears to be in favor of Republican Businessman Brent VanNorman. However, the 'unsures' continue to rise; which means, Brent is earning consideration of support from conservative-leaning Independents as well as a handful of conservative-leaning Democrats. In other words, Brent is appealing to more than Republicans.

If Brent can get his message across to voters in mass gross ratings repetitions (i.e., television) to match Karen over the final five days, and effectuate a very strong ground game, he has a solid chance of working into 1st place.
